**Naming:**

Save file as Image Name, followed by name of photographer (example: "Pink Flower – Joe Bloggs") in both upper and lower case as above and not in caps. No distinctions please as it helps keep text justification in tables tidier.

**Size:**

Max 1600 pixels in width.

Max 1200 pixels in height.

**Resolution:**

dpi can be **72 or 300** as the image will be sized by the pixel count not the dpi.

**Save as:**

JPEG/Quality12 (note: Quality 12 means maximum quality).
